Our new Neighborhood Police Officer, Brent Ladd, gave a crime report and answered questions and addressed concerns. He urged citizens to participate in the COP and Code Rangers programs.

Sandy Breaux, administrative assistant to the late Councilman Chuck Silcox, reported that she is still answering the telephone and trying to solve problems that arise in District 3. She announced that the Chuck Silcox Animal Shelter is up and running, and that anyone over 65 years of age can adopt a pet at ½ price.

Rene, who resides on Overhill, spoke on tolerance and acceptance in our neighborhood.

The door prize was awarded to Peggy Fergon.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.

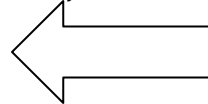
