MINUTES OF JULY 10, 2006, MEETING

Councilman Chuck Silcox gave a presentation concerning zoning changes and what our neighborhood could do to protect our property from being re-zoned and to have the correct zoning in place. More information will be given at the September meeting.

In the absence of Diana Jackson, Treasurer, the treasurer's report was carried over from the previous month.

The minutes from the May meeting were accepted.

Our Neighborhood Patrol Officer, Bobby McCarthy, handed out a map showing areas of high crime incidents, and also photos of known criminals working in our area. Officer McCarthy reported that there will be a meeting with Mayor Moncrief, Chief Mendoza and other city officials to discuss the condition of the apartments on West Vickery. In August, a petition will be passed around the neighborhood asking for an investigation of that situation.

Sheryl Cornelius proposed that our Association send a donation to the American Heart Association in memory of Diana Jackson's mother. A motion was made, seconded, and approved that this be done.
