MINUTES OF RHANA MEETING, JANUARY 8, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 by President Bruce Cox. The minutes of the November, 2006, meeting were approved as printed in the December newsletter.

Sheryl Cornelius gave a report on the two families adopted by RHANA for Christmas. We spent about \$300.00 on the families and Wal-Mart donated complete Christmas dinners for them.

David Walston from the Four Sevens Resource Co. conducted a question and answer session concerning the gas lease sign-up that is in progress.

The treasurer's report given by Diana Jackson, Treasurer, reflects a balance of \$2881.49 as of 1-02-07. The books are currently being audited.

Our NPO, Edward Ochoa, gave a report on crime activity in our area. He stated that the biggest problem in our neighborhood is car break-ins.

Bruce introduced Bill Starling, our new Code Enforcement Officer.

New Business: A suggestion was made that our association might contact the gas company, specifically Hunter Ennis, for a donation to RHANA for our help in getting everyone together to sign up for the leases. This will be looked into and reported on later.

Old Business: Brooke Ulrickson brought an estimate from her father for building our neighborhood sign. She passed around photos to show us the type of sign he would build if this is what we decide to do.

Sandi Breaux, Councilman Silcox's administrative assistant, explained the pros and cons of the current proposal before the City Council to renovate the downtown post office to make it an annex to City Hall.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

There is no water quality issue associated with these changes.
